

participation by all, regardless of experience. Adaptations of classic novels and traditional tales, developed through workshops, have been the mainstay of the group's output, but we have also



found time to fit in plays from writers such as Brecht, Churchill, Bennett, Shakespeare, Synge, Wycherley, Pinter and Beckett. In recent years the company has mounted successful productions of Charles Causley's adaptation of Hans Christian Andersen's 'The Tinderbox', Dylan Thomas' 'Under Milk Wood' and Oscar Wilde's 'The Picture of Dorian Gray'.
